


































# WHAT WE HAVE ACCOMPLISHED

## Reason for Hope has become a trusted partner in crafting state and federal policy

#### In 18 Months we have:

- Seeded a federal interagency task force
- Passed the first psychedelic pilot program legislation in the country
- Authored landmark federal legislation with Senator Booker and Paul
- Positioned state legislative reforms with national political influence




fter receiving bipartisan support from representatives of the Connecticut state legislature, Governor Ned Lamont signed a tax bill that includes a pilot program that will provide psychedelic-assisted therapy, using MDMA and psilocybin, to qualifying veterans, retired first-responders, and frontline workers such as police and firefighters. Originally drafted as the House Bill 5396, the program is designed to give access to psychedelic medicines to a population deprived of options for mental health treatments, ahead of FDA approval.

**Twenty-six states** have **initiative** and/or **veto referendum** processes at the statewide level. Half of the states are not eligible for ballot measures, many of which are the most influential to national political narrative.
